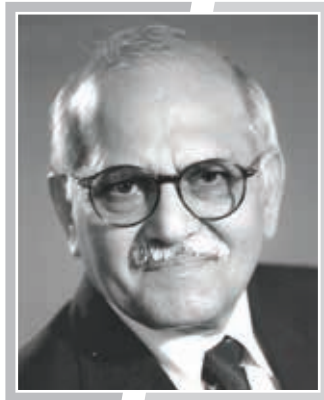

Chairman's Message

ITRHD is now in its 14th year growing from strength to strength, with many projects completed and ongoing ones in full swing.

THE HARIHARPUR SCHOOL PROJECT

One project with which I am particularly happy is the primary school in the musicians village of Hariharpur in Azamgarh, U.P. As most of you will know, this is one of three extraordinary Azamgarh villages which we have designated as a Creative Cluster. When we began working in Hariharpur, the villagers were unanimous in their plea for a school, and in 2013 we responded.

The school provides free education and takes care of all the needs of the pupils, both girls and boys — books, uniforms, mid-day meals and medical checkups. The number of students has now almost reached 100.

When we began, we needed funds for day to day running of the school, including salaries of staff and needs of students. Initially we started in rented quarters, but soon managed our own building, with 2 large rooms partitioned into 4. That was not a very satisfactory arrangement, but it was a beginning.

For mid-day meals, initially the food was cooked by a local resident, and served to the children sitting on the ground. We obviously needed a big hall which could not only serve as a dining area with attached kitchen, but could be used for other activities also. We thus focused on raising funds for a new building. This has now come up thanks to donations and mobilization of internal resources. It is an impressive building, worthy of a good school, and takes care of our present needs.

I had the pleasure of visiting the school only recently accompanied by our two Vice-Chairpersons Yogendra Narain and Maureen Liebl and our Member Secretary Archana

Capoor. I must mention that even with our being able to raise resources, the building would not have come up and as fast as it did but for the indefatigable efforts of my friend the well-known architect Shibani Ganju and his assistant Prateek Singh.

The new building marks the first phase, but to take care of our future growth we need to expand the building, for which around Rs one crore is needed. We are not keen to tap government sources which often have strings attached. Our only hope is CSR funding, but that is not easy unless one has personal contacts. Still, we have not given up hope. Where there is a will there is a way.

For day to day running of the school we hit upon a novel approach. We sent a request to our members and friends to support the school with a token donation of Rs.3000 (now raised to Rs.5000) every year, the cost of sponsoring one child. The response was very heart warming, with a number of persons sponsoring more than one child. Thus we have been able to raise enough funds for the school to run smoothly.

I have been particularly concerned about the school's future after the present leadership is not there. In the day to day running of the school I do not wish a crisis to develop for want of funds. We have, therefore decided to set up a corpus for the school with an initial target of Rs 5 crores so that from the interest of the corpus the basic requirements of the school are met. We have so far been able to raise Rs.48.55 lacs.

The school has been doing well. The faculty are locally recruited young women. Though they are dedicated and educated, they are not very proficient in English. We are searching for someone to fill this gap. Meanwhile the young teachers travel to Delhi regularly, where we provide them with various types of training.

MUSIC AND CRAFT TRADITIONS

Our efforts to support music and craft traditions, many of them centuries old, have met with great success. The black pottery tradition of Nizamabad (another of our "Creative Cluster" villages in Azamgarh) was in the doldrums. These potters had originally come from Surat in the time of Emperor Aurangzeb and had been doing fairly well. By the time we became involved, middlemen had captured the trade, leaving the artisans with a pittance. Many of them, in despair had migrated to Mumbai and were selling bhel puri. We urged them to come back promising them full support. They did so.

Among our initiatives was exposing the artisans to sophisticated buyers in Delhi, and later in Lucknow, with exhibitions at high-profile venues. We take care of all expenses, and do not take from them a single paisa. All the profits go to the potters, and middlemen are out. We also helped them in diversifying their products, and the market responded. Training programmes to improve their skills were also organised. Today the village is humming with activity. Sohit, a master potter, won the President's Award and he has set up a training school for potters in the village. He very proudly mentioned to me that the Bank turned their noses when he approached them earlier. Now the same bank has given him a loan of Rs one crore to set up the training school. The quality of the products can be judged by the fact that the Prime Minister took some pottery from this village for presentation to the Japanese Prime Minister.

A similar situation existed in the third Azamgarh “Creative Cluster” village, Mubarakpur, where a handloom tradition dating back about 400 years still exists. Ibn Battuta, the famous 14th century Moroccan traveler, in fact visited the village and mentioned it in his travelogue.

The weavers were still producing excellent saris, but they were being marketed as Benarsi saris, and again were dependent on middlemen. We began by providing them the same exhibition facilities as we did for the potters, in our highly publicized “Azamgarh Festivals.” These have led to increasing recognition, and gradual design and product diversification as they interacted with the urban buyers. Gradually their handlooms have once again become recognized as Mubarakpur weavings. We have been providing full support to the craftspersons of both the villages without a break for over 12 years now, and it is very heartening to see the impact it has had on their lives.

Hariharpur, where the primary school is located, boasts of a classical music tradition, dating back to several hundred years. Every Brahman family in this village has a classical musician, vocal or instrumental. If you visit the village in the early hours of the morning you will be pleased to see youngsters doing Riaz alongside their grandparents.

A feeling of frustration was, however, building up as they found few opportunities of performing beyond their village circles. We have not only provided training and guidance, but have included their performances in our Azamgarh Festivals. They are now gaining their own identity as the Hariharpur Gharana.

We have now been supporting these Azamgarh traditions for the last 12 years, and are grateful for the financial support that we have received from both public and private sector organisations, as well as our members.

A NEW AND EXCITING INITIATIVE

Several years ago, we also began identifying endangered traditions in other states. We began working in Rajasthan, and on the advice of our Trustee Maharaja Gaj Singh of Jodhpur, decided to focus on Barmer. We accompanied him to a few villages to interact with the artisans and musicians. Again, the traditions were endangered and not being passed down to the next generation.

As a first step we organized intensive workshops in several villages, and then invited them to join our Azamgarh Festivals. Maureen Liebl, one of our Vice Chairpersons, and Amrita Singh, our life Trustee, with their long history of work in Jodhpur, took charge. With CSR financial support from a Bhiwani based company, Hindustan Gum and Chemicals, and the unflagging support of the Jodhpur Royal Family and the Mehrangarh Museum Trust, they have also begun exploring other avenues of significant potential. I requested Maureen for a few words on the Rajasthan operations and in her words,:

Since 2019, we have had a project for LIVELIHOOD ENHANCEMENT IN HERITAGE-RICH AREAS OF WESTERN RAJASTHAN, linking the sustainable preservation of the area’s rich heritage assets, both cultural and natural, to enhanced livelihood opportunities. These have included workshops focusing on women and younger residents of artisan communities, exhibitions of work of master artisans in high-profile venues, and environmental initiatives. In

the last year we collaborated with DASTKAR to provide comprehensive development to two fine craft communities.

Recently we have been working on the comprehensive development of Gundiya Nadi, an extraordinary village on the Jodhpur/Barmer border, rich both in natural resources and community motivation. We have been able to support a number of initiatives in the village, and as mentioned last year, are now working to preserve the unique natural resources (including an oren, water bodies, and endangered wildlife).

These are extremely sensitive areas, and require carefully planned intervention. At the suggestion of Trustee Maharaja Gaj Singh-ji ("Bapji"), we enlisted the help of Dr. Manu Bhatnagar, Principal Director of the Natural Heritage Division of INTACH. Along with our field officer Arvind Yadav, he visited the village in early June. Project Leader Surendra Choudhary arranged an intensive program, in which Dr. Bhatnagar was able to meet all involved community leaders and see our various initiatives, as well as survey the water bodies and surrounding areas. He gave us a very comprehensive preliminary report, and we are now working with him to plan the next phase of the work.

Gundiya Nadi has real potential to serve as a model village for other communities, both Rajasthan and elsewhere. It is an exciting and important initiative.

CONSERVATION INITIATIVES

We had our first opportunity of taking up a conservation project in Haryana. In a village in the town of NUH lies a magnificent Dargah 700 years old, attracting a large number of pilgrims. It was in a state of collapse and the Chairman of the Haryana WAQF Board, a former colleague of mine, mentioned that he needed some expert to restore the Dargah before it collapsed. I told him that our organisation could do it. An MOU was signed and with some funds from the WAQF Board, from the Haryana Govt and some from ASI, the work was completed to the delight of the local inhabitants. Preeti Harit, our conservation architect, under the able supervision of our Vice-Chairman Prof. AGK Menon, did an impressive job.

Soon after, we were fortunate to get two assignments in the state of Jharkhand. A village on the Bengal border, Maluti, had at one point of time 106 terracotta temples, with only 62 endangered ones still extant. The State Govt, without calling for bids, on a nomination basis entrusted the work to us at a cost of Rs.7 crores, which was formally launched on line by the Prime Minister. The work is in progress. Another project relating to an old jail building in Ranchi where a freedom fighter tribal leader Birsa Munda had been jailed was also entrusted to us by the State Govt of Jharkhand on nomination basis, at a total cost of Rs.9 crores. Our conservation team under Shreedeo Singh our HART (Heritage Ambassador for Rural Tradition) has done an excellent job.

We were also entrusted to undertake a detailed documentation of all heritage properties in the villages of Varanasi and Ballia by the UP Govt. The work was completed on time with photographs and detailed information about each property by Preeti Harit our architect who earlier on our own initiative had taken up a similar project in the Munnar region of Kerala.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

As an organisation we strongly feel that there is need for a Govt corporation to be set with a capital of at least Rs 1000 crores to provide funding to organisations having the necessary expertise to take up documentation of heritage properties all over rural India. On the basis of such documentation selected properties for conservation could be identified and their adaptive use decided finally for community purposes

ITRHD has also during the last 13 years or so has been bringing out two very prestigious magazines. One relates to specific themes - such as *Traditional Cuisines of India; Oral Traditions, Myths & Legends of India; Traditional Healing systems of India; Rural Sports & Games of India; and Tribal Culture of India*. The other magazine features articles from eminent people in India and abroad on different aspects of rural life. We have also been organising seminars focusing on specific issues such as need for greater support to the handloom sector or the need to give a thrust to rural tourism and its linkage with overall rural development.

CURRENT MAJOR PROJECT

A recent project that we have launched, a very challenging one, relates to the setting up of an Academy for management and preservation of Buddhist rural heritage.

Buddhism, as is well known, had its origins in India and from here it established its foothold in many other countries. In India there is a great revival of interest in Buddhism. India is home to numerous significant Buddhist pilgrim sites which include Bodh Gaya (where the Buddha attained enlightenment) and Sarnath (where he read his first sermon), and several others. These attract thousands of tourists from all over the world. In addition to the famous sites, however, there are thousands of undiscovered sites in rural areas spread all over the country. ITRHD decided that it was time that attention was paid to these sites which after documentation and conservation would not only be a further attraction for tourists but would be a source of attraction, inspiration and learning for local communities.

As a first step in this direction a decision was taken to set up an institute for management and preservation of Buddhist rural heritage (PBRH). A very challenging decision - in fact one of my Trustees was feeling uncomfortable and remarked at one of our meetings "whether we have taken more than we can chew." Fortunately, he now agrees that he was wrong but the fact nevertheless was that it was certainly an uphill task with many mountains to climb. We reminded ourselves that Mount Everest had been conquered; that kept us going.

Since Andhra Pradesh is a state with a wealth of undiscovered Buddhist sites, we felt that it would be an ideal location. The AP Govt was approached to be a partner with us in this project. As a first step we requested for 5 acres of land at a suitable site free of cost which has been agreed to.

The next step is to ensure that the proposed academy attains the highest standards of excellence to attract scholars and students from both India and neighboring countries having a Buddhist tradition. I would also like to make it clear that the academy would focus on both tangible and intangible heritage. Apart from monasteries and other built sites Buddhism, is extraordinarily rich in its intangible heritage which "encompasses traditions,

living expressions, oral traditions, performing arts, social practices, rituals, festive events, knowledge of nature and the universe and traditional craftsmanship. It also includes languages, stories, and folk lore passed through generations.”

To achieve this objective we are organising an international conference in Delhi this year from November 28–30 to discuss all issues relating to the setting up of the Academy. A number of eminent scholars from India and abroad have already sent their confirmations. A professional journal on issues relating to Buddhism is under preparation edited by Amal Allana which will be formally released at the inaugural function. A play on the Life of Buddha will also be part of the conference activities. It is being directed by Lushin Dubey and has had a successful run in US.

For the inaugural function we have invited the Prime Minister -confirmation yet to be received. The Prime Minister of Bhutan was also invited through our Trustee Prof Prajapati Trivedi whose student he was at Harvard University. He has accepted.

ITRHD has constituted a Steering Committee to organise the conference with our main partners:

- School of Planning and Architecture Delhi
- Gautam Buddha University Noida
- International Buddhist Confederation (under the Ministry of Culture)
- Archaeological Survey of India
- International Buddhist Association of America based in Berkley U.S and represented by Wangmo Dixey/ The Lights of Buddhadharma Foundation International

ITRHD is represented by its Chairman S.K. Misra, Vice Chairmen Yogendra Narain and AGK Menon, Member Secretary Archana Capoor, Conservation architect Preeti Harit and Coordinator of the Conference and my aide-in Chief Sujit Sanyal.

In addition, some individuals — Madan Bezbaruah, former Tourism Secretary to Govt of India, Navin Berry Tourism expert and editor of several publications, Bhushan Kachru, an icon in the hospitality sector, Prof Prajapati Trivedi and Navin Piplani — have been actively involved in the Steering Committee, which has done an excellent job in taking us nearer to goal.

A core in-house group under the able leadership of Prof. AGK Menon, includes Anuradha Chaturvedi of the School of Planning and Architecture Delhi, Archana Capoor Member Secretary of ITRHD, and the eminent architect Shibani Ganju. ITRHD's architect Preeti Harit and Sujit Sanyal, coordinator for the conference and aide-in Chief to the Chairman, have been working tirelessly on all issues relating to the Conference and putting up recommendations to the Steering Committee for final decisions. As a result of their efforts much has been accomplished and we are hopeful that the Conference will be a great driving force in our efforts to set up the Academy, the first of its kind in the country. A major hurdle, however has yet to be crossed - the finances required but hopefully by the grace of God we will meet our targets.

FINANCES

A word about the state of our finances. It will surprise everyone to know that when ITRHD was formally registered we did not have even one paisa in our account. We personally approached a few public and private sector companies to become Corporate members of the organisation on payment of Rs.10 lacs each. Fully satisfied at our credentials and the fact that our Trustees were distinguished persons from different walks of life, we were able to enroll 8 Corporate members and start with a bank account of Rs.80 lacs. Thereafter we went on a membership drive in different categories — life members at one time fee of Rs 5000, institutional membership at Rs 25,000 one-time payment, and some other categories to induct students, farmers and rural residents on nominal payments. In a short time we had 400 life members and around 19 institutional members. The amounts generated became part of our corpus. As mentioned in the beginning, one of our first projects was setting up of the Hariharpur primary school, for which our members and friends have generously contributed.

We then decided, to support to traditional craftspersons and classical musicians, and have managed to secure support from both the private and public sectors. Our first architectural conservation project of the Nuh Dargah, was supported by the Government of Haryana, the WAQF Bord, and a nominal amount from ASI. The major conservation projects in Jharkhand were entrusted to us on a nomination basis. Similarly some documentation of rural heritage properties in a couple of UP villages also landed in our lap from the State Govt.

We also decided to bring out two prestigious magazines every year, as mentioned above. Advertisements earn us Rs.25,000 per page. A few years back the Ministry of Culture gave us a Corpus grant of Rs.5 crores., the interests of which helps to sustain our ongoing projects or take up new ones. From the funds that we receive, we keep 10–15% for meeting administrative costs.

After covid sources of funding started drying up and State Govts changed their policy of awarding projects only after bids had been received. We started having problems meeting our expenditure on administration. We have had to resort to economy measures such as giving up our office accommodation and using the residential premises of a Trustee as office.

We still have considerable needs to be fulfilled. The decision to hold an international conference to focus on Preservation of Buddhist Rural Heritage (PBRH) is a big challenge and efforts are on to mobilise financial support.

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT**To the Members of Indian Trust for Rural Heritage and Development****Report on the Audit of Financial Statements****Opinion**

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of **Indian Trust for Rural Heritage and Development** (the society), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at 31st March, 2025, the Statement of Income & Expenditure and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information.

In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the financial statements, read with other notes given thereto, give a true and fair view in conformity with the accounting principles generally accepted in India:

- i) in the case of the Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Society as at 31st March 2025; and
- ii) in the case of the Income and Expenditure Account, of the loss for the year ended on that date.

Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing (SAs) issued by ICAI. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Society in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) together with the ethical requirements that are relevant to our audit of financial statements, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

Responsibilities of management and those charged with governance for the financial statements

Management of Society is responsible for the preparation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position and financial performance of the Society in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the accounting standards issued by ICAI, to the extent applicable. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records for safeguarding of the assets of the Society and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate implementation and maintenance of accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statement that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

In preparing the financial statements, management is responsible for assessing the Society's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going concern and using the going concern basis of accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Society or to cease

operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so. The Society's Management is responsible for overseeing the financial reporting process.

Auditors' responsibility for the audit of the financial statements

Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatement can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these financial statements.

As part of an audit in accordance with SAs, we exercise professional judgment and maintain professional skepticism throughout the audit. We also:

- Identify and assess the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error, design and perform audit procedures responsive to those risks, and obtain audit evidence that is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion. The risk of not detecting a material misstatement resulting from fraud is higher than for one resulting from error, as fraud may involve collusion, forgery, intentional omissions, misrepresentations, or the override of internal control.
- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by management.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of management's use of the going concern basis of accounting and based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related to events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Society's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our auditor's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Society to cease to continue as a going concern.
- Evaluate the overall presentation, structure and content of the financial statements, including the disclosures, and whether the financial statements represent the underlying transactions and events in a manner that achieves fair presentation.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

Other matters

We report that:

- a) We have sought and obtained all the information and explanations, which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit;
- b) In our opinion proper books of account have been kept so far as appears from our examination of those books; and
- c) The Balance Sheet and Income and Expenditure Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

1 General Information

The society was incorporated on 25/03/2011 and was registered as a society in New Delhi vide registration no. S/534.Distt South/2011 dated 23rd June 2011. The PAN of the society is AAAAI4704J.2.The society has been registered with Income Tax Authorities u/s 12(A)(a) as a Charitable Institution.The society has received registration under Section 12 A of the Income Tax Act, 1961 on 17th October, 2011 and 12A registration no. is DEL-IR21616-17102011. The registration has been renewed by the commissioner of Income Tax for a period of five years, i.e. AY 2022-23 to AY 2026-27, vide Unique Registration Number: AAAAI4704JE20119 dated 24th September 2021, under the Income Tax Act, 1961 and Rules made thereunder.

2 Significant Accounting Policies

(i) Basis of Accounting

These financial statements are prepared in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles in India under the historical cost convention on Cash Basis. These financial statements have been prepared to comply in all material aspects with the accounting standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India, for Non-company entities except where otherwise stated. The Accounting Policies adopted for preparation of financial statements are consistent with those of previous years.

Life Membership fees:

Life Membership fees received from members forms part of Corpus Fund unless otherwise stated by the member.

The society has renewed its registration under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 on 24th September 2021 and the Unique registration number is AAAAI4704JF20216 which is valid for AY 2022-23 to AY 2026-27 under the Income Tax Act, 1961 and Rules made thereunder.

Other Income: Interest

Interest income on Fixed Deposit is recognized on a time proportion basis taking into account the amount outstanding and the rate as applicable. Interest on Savings Account is taken as and when received.

(iii) Use of Estimates

The preparation of final statements in conformity with generally accepted accounting principles requires estimates and assumptions to be made that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities on the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Differences between actual results and estimates are recognised in the period in which the results are known.

(iv) Property Plant and Equipment and Depreciation

a) Property plant and equipment:

Tangibles:

All Property Plant and Equipment are stated at cost of acquisition or construction less accumulated depreciation and includes adjustment arising from exchange rate variations attributable to them, if any.Fixed Assets were physically verified by the management during the year; and no discrepancies were found during such verification.

b) Depreciation:

Tangibles:

Deprecation on tangible property plant and equipment has been provided on written down value method as per the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act 1961,. Depreciation on the property plant and equipment purchased during the year has been at full rate if used for more than 180 days in a year and at half the rate of the allowable depreciation for assets used for less than 180 days in a year.
